Christ Blessing Little Children, by Charles Lock Eastlake (1839)

In today's gospel Jesus explains that the profound bond between a man and a woman has its origin in the very beginning of creation, when God made them male and female. It is part of God's divine plan that husband and wife should be no longer two, but one body. The loving physical union of husband and wife, Jesus explains, is rooted in the very creation of woman and man: the two being both of Adam's flesh.

Marriage in the Catholic faith is one of the seven sacraments. What the Church is saying is that the truly loving and life-giving bond of husband and wife is sacred. Christ himself is made manifest through the love of husband and wife. Their loving communion – expressed most profoundly when the two are one – is nothing less than a sign of the communion of Christ with his Church. As Christ gave himself completely for the Church, so wife and husband give themselves completely in love for one another. **Mgr Matthew**
