The Letter to the Hebrews speaks of Jesus as the High Priest who has entered the highest heaven. Christ is indeed the true priest who has offered his life in sacrifice for the reconciliation of mankind with God. Yet Christ's resurrection and ascension have not separated him from us. The whole point of the incarnation is that our High Priest is one 'who has been tempted in every way that we are, though he is without sin.' It is because the Son of God became a human being in Jesus Christ that we can come to him as we are. We do not pretend to be any better than we truly are, but trust in his mercy and forgiveness.

It is a wonderful thing to be a Christian: to be one entrusted by God to share in his mission to bring the Good News of salvation to this world. Like the apostles – with all their faults and failings – we too are called to be witnesses to the risen Christ and to build his Kingdom in this world. We can only do that by surrendering ourselves to Christ and serving him with humility and love.
