The Seven Deadly Sins and the Four Last Things by Hieronymus Bosch (disputed) c. 1500

Today's gospel asks us to see where the corrosiveness of sin eats away at our discipleship of Christ: the fault lines in our lives of faith. Not just the sins that come to mind so easily, but the more subtle workings of Satan: the presumption that we are better than other people; our exclusion of others simply because they are different from ourselves. If we really open ourselves to Jesus Christ we will experience the transforming power of his love. If we really say - and pray - 'God, help me in my weakness, pull me up from the mire of my own foolishness and stand me on my feet again' - God will do it. We have, in the Sacrament of Reconciliation, the absolute reality of the forgiveness of God and we receive the strength of the Holy Spirit to renew our lives of faith.

Do not doubt the power of God to heal, to forgive, to strengthen you in your discipleship of Jesus Christ. Give him all that is broken in your life, and he will give you the strength to overcome it. **Mgr Matthew**
